"Social inclusion has massive benefits in improving mental health, That's why we tried to keep connect-ed and reduce loneli-ness and isolation," Ms Meggetto said. Warragul local, Rhiannon has an experience of Asperger's Syndrome. This is a condition that affects the way people cope with situations, relate to other people and communicate. It was for this reason, that Rhiannon enlisted help from atWork Australia's Disability Employment Services.

A meeting was scheduled with a dedicated Job Coach, who devised a job plan around Rhiannon's skills, challenges and goals. She received resume assistance and valuable insights into the labour market. The Job

Coach contacted local employers and discovered a job vacancy at The Blue Dolphin Fish and Chippery.

The Job Coach discussed interview strategies and negotiated a support plan for both Rhiannon and employer. Rhiannon was offered the job and couldn't be happier. Working with a supportive family business, meant that she was able to sustain employment through the COVID-19 pandemic and Chippery expressed, "Rhiannon is just lovely to have around. She is always very positive and reliable". reliable
